IDENTIFYING JOB SHADOWING OPPORTUNITIES:

- Who do you know already doing the job you want to shadow?
- If you do not know someone already, ask your advisor, instructors, or Career Services for suggestions.
- OR, make phone calls to businesses you are interested in. Ask to speak to an office manager or hiring official.

ASKING PERMISSION TO JOB SHADOW:

"I am a college student interested in learning about jobs in your industry. I was wondering if you take interns or allow job shadowing?"

Examples of Job Shadowing Interview Questions

AUTOMOTIVE

- What types of mechanical, computerized or technical equipment have you used to test cars?
- What are your best qualities when it comes to providing customer care?

AVIATION

- Tell me about your aircraft.
- Pilots have simultaneous responsibilities during a flight. What advise can you give me about balancing those responsibilities?

BUSINESS

- Describe a business problem you faced and how you handled it
- What are two to three industry or management trends that impact your role?

CRIMINAL JUSTICE

- What are some misconceptions people may have about law enforcement professionals?
- What type of continuing education and training is provided on this job?

CULINARY ARTS

- How involved are you in the menu development?
- What was the biggest mistake you made when you were a brand new chef?

HEALTH INFORMATION

- How do you keep track of all the data you track so that the work gets done on time?
- Share a time in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your company.

INFORMATION SCIENCE

- Tell me about the most recent project you worked on. What were your responsibilities?
- How would you rate your key competencies needed for this job?

NURSING

- How do you create a great patient experience?
- Are their any duties you perform that you did not expect you would be required or asked to perform?

TEACHING

- Tell me about the planning and preparation teaching requires.
- How do you handle unexpected situations/ behavioral problems?

Tips for Successful Job Shadowing

- ♦ Prepare questions ahead of time.
- ♦ Dress, speak and act professionally.
- ♦ Bring paper and pencil to take notes.
- ♦ Pick a time that works best for you and the person you're shadowing.
